Scrapping for metal is **PROHIBITED** and will be strictly enforced by the Danbury Police. Clean-up week will also be held October 16 thru 20.



THANK YOU RESIDENTS! Here is our new 2017 Custom Sutphen Pumper with a 1500 gallon per minute pump. It holds 1000 gallons of water, has a foam system, is equipped with a light tower, thermal imaging camera and remote monitor nozzle. It carries over 2000 feet of hose along with several tools and enclosed seating for 6 firefighters. It replaces a 21 year-old pumper.
